1. POLICY STATEMENT

The health, safety, and security of our employees, contractors and those who may be affected by our operations, is an integral part of our business. Our goal is zero harm to people and the environment.

We recognise that responsibilities for health, safety, security, and environmental (HSSE) management, are of equal importance to the ISO14001:2015 and ISO45001:2018 standards.

Every individual has the obligation to stop a job or act if s/he considers the risks involved to be unacceptable.

OSC is committed to a system of HSSE management based on a common understanding of risks and how to control them. We are committed to preventing injury and ill health of all employees and contractors. We will engage the support of our employees and contractors, identify risks arising from our work and eliminate or reduce them to as low as is reasonably practicable.

HSSE protection are everyone's responsibility, and a prime responsibility of all levels of management and supervision. OSC's contractors will conduct their operations in accordance with our policy and the management system will enable them to take an appropriate proactive approach towards our goal of zero harm.

All employees and contractors will achieve this by:


- Compliance, as a minimum, with all applicable legislation, OSC's policies and other requirements;
- Setting, monitoring, and review of HSSE objectives and targets;
- Clearly defining HSSE roles and responsibilities;
- Implementing and continuously improving an occupational risk management system consistent with OSC's standards;
- Providing suitable and sufficient occupational HSSE information, instruction, and training to enable all staff to carry out their jobs competently;



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- Selection and monitoring of competent contractors to ensure appropriate standards are achieved in accordance with OSC's policy;
- Reviewing the management system and policy to ensure their suitability, adequacy and effectiveness;
- Continual and effective improvement of H&S performance;
- We will provide adequate and appropriate resources to implement this policy and will ensure it is properly communicated and understood; and,
- OSC's aim is to encourage involvement and adopt best practice in a culture where employees and managers are aware of their individual HSE responsibilities, and are actively engaged and committed to improving standards and meeting our goal of zero harm.
